Ladies and gentlemen,

We have received your inquiry regarding the TSCA ((Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6 (h)).

The new regulations, published by the U.S. EPA (Environmental Protection Agency) on 06.01.2021 and relating to the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6(h), are intended to restrict the import into and use in the USA of five chemicals.

For implementation of the law, the EPA has published a list of those chemicals which are suspected of causing cancer or of being toxic for reproduction.
